Visitor policy statement

United Way British Columbia (UWBC) recognizes the importance of keeping our employees, volunteers, interns, and contractors safe. **As of October 18, 2021, UWBC has introduced a mandatory COVID-19 Vaccination Policy** for anyone entering a UWBC building and expects to be fully compliant by November 22, 2021.

UWBC requires all visitors to a UWBC building to provide proof of full vaccination against COVID-19 and identification or if you are medically exempt, a recent negative COVID-19 test when entering the facility.

Any non-staff persons entering a UWBC building that cannot provide valid proof of vaccination or proof of a recent negative COVID-19 test is required to take a Regular Antigen Point of Care Testing for COVID-19 ("RAT") rapid test and demonstrate a negative result prior to attending any on-site United Way work. This test will be supplied and administered when you arrive at the office. If an individual tests positive they will be instructed to leave the premises and seek further COVID-19 testing at a COVID-19 assessment centre. Return to any UWBC site will not be permitted until the individual is medically cleared.
